Guided tour and stained-glass demonstration with Justin Tyner

SOUTH STREET, PHILADELPHIA, PA – Experience Justin Tyner’s exhibition at Philadelphia’s Magic Gardens, [Light as Memory: Recollections Through Stained Glass](#), through a tour and demonstration on Wednesday, July 24, from 6:00 – 9:00 PM. The tour portion will take place at Philadelphia’s Magic Gardens, and the demonstration and hands-on activity will happen at Tattooed Mom.

Philadelphia artist Justin Tyner constructs stained glass creations that thoughtfully mix discarded and recycled bottles and fallen stained glass from abandoned Philadelphia churches. Pieced together poems, kaleidoscopic patterns, and geometric forms make up his compositions, all of which filter natural light to create limitless color combinations. Tyner’s works pay tribute to the history behind the materials he uses, and remind us that inspiration can come from even the most forgotten places.

Tyner will guide guests through his exhibition at Philadelphia’s Magic Gardens and lead a casual discussion about the meaning behind his work. Then participants will follow Tyner down South Street to Tattooed Mom for a stained glass demonstration. All attendees are welcome to relax and create their own Tyner-inspired crafts: tissue paper stained glass and “Tyner Transparencies.”
