WHAT: Philadelphia's Magic Gardens' Pop-Up Museum events are free and family-friendly. Their goal is to connect with communities in the city and introduce people to the many mosaic murals created by PMG Founder Isaiah Zagar that can be seen throughout the streets of Philadelphia. A total of four events are scheduled to occur during the summer of 2019, each in a different neighborhood.

At the Fitness Works event guests can press rubber stamps and lace doilies into wet clay to make their own unique "tile," and explore local mural with a scavenger hunt.
